We understand that we are a University located in a peripheral area quite far off from the Metropolis and our employees have no other option but to travel regularly either by train or by road. But the Vice Chancellor is deeply concerned about the safety of every member of the University community and takes this opportunity to remind everyone that safety saves lives.
