A large number of teachers, scholars, and researchers from Economics, Geography and related social science disciplines are expected to participate in this prestigious two-day national event. In addition to research paper presentations in the technical sessions, keynote and special lectures by eminent academicians have also been arranged.

Concept Note

Sustainable regional development integrates economic growth, social inclusion, and environmental protection within specific regions to promote long-term prosperity. Emerging as a response to the limitations of traditional economic models, it emphasizes balancing ecological health with economic and social needs. By aligning regional strategies with the 2030 SDG targets, this approach enables governments and organizations to address region-specific challenges, fostering resilience and equitable growth. The focus is on spreading economic benefits across various regions, reducing disparities, and preserving natural resources and cultural heritage for future generations.

The conference will cover nine subthemes, including rural development, urbanization, environmental sustainability, and infrastructure development, among others. Experts, scholars and stakeholders will explore together discuss the pressing issues and challenges in this field and suggest innovative and cross-cutting strategies that can lead to balanced and inclusive

growth across diverse regions. This collaboration aims to create policies that address both immediate and long-term regional or spatial disparities, ensuring sustainable and equitable development across the country.

Sub Themes

- 1. Rural Development and Agriculture:** Enhancing rural infrastructure, boosting agricultural productivity, and expanding livelihood opportunities for holistic rural growth.
- 2. Urbanization and Smart Cities:** Implementing sustainable urban planning and smart city technologies to promote balanced and efficient regional development.
- 3. Industrial Growth and MSME Development:** Exploring sustainable practices in industry and MSMEs to foster long-term economic and environmental health.
- 4. Infrastructure Development:** Developing resilient transportation, energy, communication and social infrastructures to support sustainable regional growth.
- 5. Environmental Sustainability and SDG Goals:** Addressing climate change, conserving natural resources, and promoting eco-friendly practices to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- 6. Social Sector Development and Inclusion:** Promoting inclusive growth by addressing poverty, inequality, social disparities, ensuring equity, social protection and improving social services like education and health.
- 7. Tourism, Cultural Heritage, and Local Economies:** Supporting sustainable tourism that preserves cultural heritage while enhancing local economic development.

8. **Community Participation and Governance:** Encouraging local community involvement and effective governance models to ensure relevant and sustainable regional development.
9. **Vikshit Bharat:** Outlining a roadmap for transforming India into a developed nation through regional development initiatives.
10. **Coastal Landscape and Development:** Issues, initiatives and experiences.

Submission Guidelines

Interested participants are requested to send their original research papers of 3000-6000 words for the conference along with an abstract of around 250-400 words, mentioning the sub- theme and details of the affiliation and contacts of the paper writers to the convenor of the conference in the following email:
